Think of some of the must-see critters, e.g. pygmy seahorses, flamboyant cuttlefish, wunderpus, hairy frogfish, etc, they are found here!

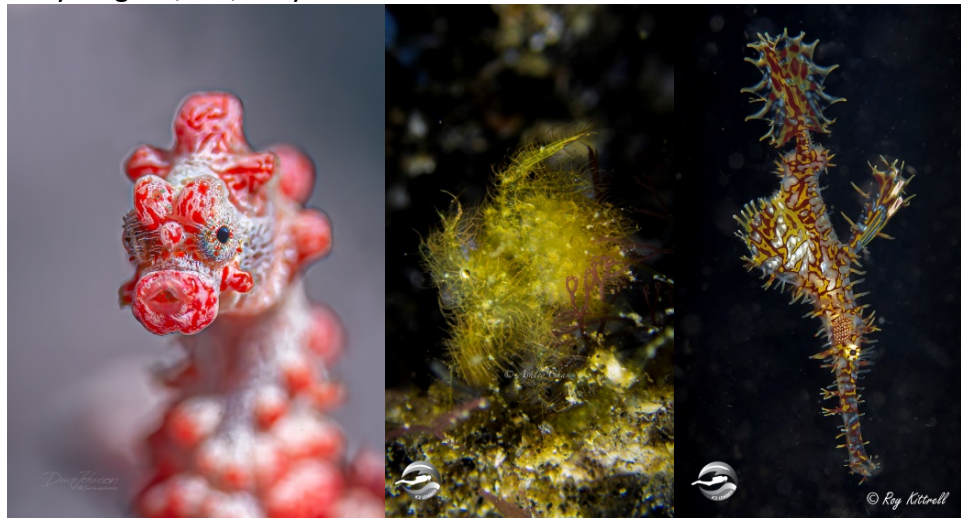

How to get
there?



Fly to Sam Ratulangi Int'l Airport (MDC), Manado, Indonesia, from:


- Singapore via Scoot
- Indonesia (Jakarta and Bali)

Transfer from airport: 35 min car ride and 8 min boat ride.

We will meet and greet at MDC airport.



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<p>Diving at Lembbeh</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Our dive groups are kept small, each dive master is assigned to 2-3 divers. Our eagle eye DM will spot the critters and will assist the photographer to get the best shots they came for. • Lembbeh is in a protected strait, with little current (except for change of tide and channelling between islets) and no waves. • The dives are usually relatively shallow, and relaxed, slow diving, as the objectives are to find the exotic creatures at the dive sites. • Most dive sites are black sandy bottom, some with fringing reefs. • Diving can be done year round, although it gets a little rainy in December, diving is still possible. • We are located 1° north of the equator, and so we enjoy balmy tropical weather year round. Air temperature range from 26-32°C, while water temperature range from 25-29°C. Think Singapore (also 1° north) in terms of weather conditions, it would be quite similar.
<p>Who are we?</p>	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We are a boutique resort with 6 villas, 7 rooms, catering to between 14 and 21 divers. • All villas have unobstructed sea view, with veranda and spaced out for a very private setting for all guests. • Our resort is located at the south side of Lembbeh Island, facing the Lembbeh Strait.
<p>Beyond Lembbeh</p>	<p>We can make day trips to Bunaken National Park for the blue water wall dives, or work with our partner resorts to give the best services to our guests for a trip to Manado. Day trips to visit land-based nature reserve and cultural sight-seeing can be arranged.</p> <p>We can also help with arrangements for diving at further locations, e.g. Raja Ampat, Bali, Philippines, etc.</p>
